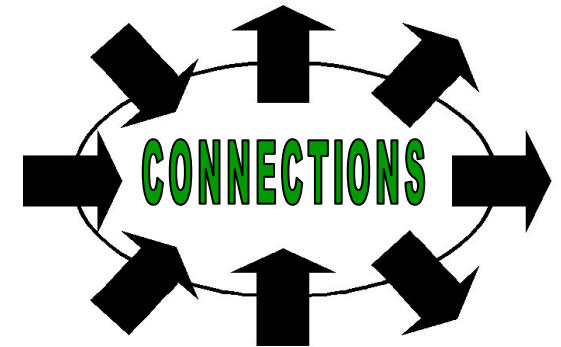

## MISSION

Connecting Daviess County residents to resources that meet their needs

## VALUE...

As churches and service providers refer calls to CONNECTIONS, a valuable database of information develops which helps identify services many individuals may be unaware exists. It also reduces the occurrence of duplication of services and time spent researching calls.

Channeling calls through CONNECTIONS minimizes the duplication of services, misuse of the system and exploitation of limited community resources.

## INFORMATION AND REFERRAL

CONNECTIONS managed 4,643 calls for information and assistance in 2013 and helped 436 households with 2,042 household members get \$54,347 in assistance.

An application is completed and referrals are made to the appropriate resources that may be able to help resulting in 66% of the applicants receiving help.

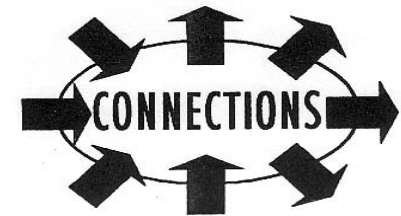
CONNECTIONS works closely with the Salvation Army, Trustees, St. Vincent, Feed My Sheep and many churches to find resources and reduce duplication of services.

## C.R.O.P.

Community Resources, Organizations and Programs is a social network meeting sponsored by CONNECTIONS. The group meets bi-monthly on the second Tuesday of the month at 11:30. Each meeting begins with a speaker presenting information about a program or resource available in the county followed by a time for the agencies to network and share information.
